Located on the South Campus of San Jacinto College, CHECHS students earn dual diplomas and graduate each year with an Associate Degree from San Jacinto College and a High School Diploma with Endorsements from CCISD. Eighth grade students in CCISD may apply in January - February to participate in the lottery selection for the freshman class. All coursework is taught in the honors format, either at the Pre-Advanced Placement, Advanced Placement, or College Dual Credit level. The majority of the students at CHECHS meet one of the four target population criterion defined by the Texas Education Agency (TEA): Students are first generation college goers, or are from minority groups traditionally underrepresented on college campuses, or are economically disadvantaged, or meet one of the thirteen Texas at-risk indicators.
